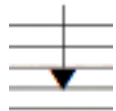

Performance Notes

1. *Galvanization of the Goddess* is a piece written for two flutes and soprano. The text is the composer's own and was inspired by her interest in alternative media and literature concerning the opening and expanding of human consciousness. The style and techniques used in the piece were inspired by her emerging interest in a branch of Korean singing known as, "jeongga," which can be heard in the scalar passages, decorative ornaments, and the unvoiced fricative percussive breathing sounds.
2. The three instruments can be amplified (if possible) using conventional microphones
3. All players should stand for the entire duration of the piece
4. All note heads have specific sounds, techniques, and/or timbres. See the legend below.
